Below are some answers to frequently asked questions about club membership.

How do I become a ROTARIAN?

What qualifies someone to join Rotary? A prospective member must be in good standing in the community, devoted to high ethical standards, willing to serve the local and international community, and be an individual able to manage their own time.

How does an individual become a Rotarian? To join, you must have a sponsor. Your sponsor will invite you to a meeting where you can meet other Rotarians and experience a Rotary meeting.

Where does Rotary meet? We meet each Wednesday at noon at the O'Meara Brothers Brewing Company, 901 Bevins Street Lakeport. Occasionally we will meet offsite at another location. Please check our meetings calendar at www.lakeportrotary.org

What are the current financial obligations of belonging to the Rotary Club of Lakeport? (Rotary Fiscal Year: July 1—June 30)

Are there minimum attendance requirements? To remain in good standing, a 60% attendance record is expected. Meetings missed are easy to make up. Attendance at regularly scheduled committee meetings, board meetings, new member orientations, Club social functions all count as a meeting make-up. Additionally, you can make-up a missed meeting by attending other Rotary Club meetings two weeks prior or two weeks after a missed meeting.

What is the New Membership process? Your Sponsor will ask you to complete a prospective Member Application and return it. The Application will be submitted to the Board for consideration. Upon approval, you will be notified immediately. As soon as scheduling allows, you will be introduced to the Club by your sponsor/Club President during a regular club meeting. At this meeting, you will receive name badge and introductory materials.

Is there a New Member Orientation? The Rotary Club of Lakeport is committed to help new members find their place in the Rotary World, availing all aspects of service to better the world around us. Your sponsor or a member of our membership team will provide you a one-to-one New Member Orientation at a mutually agreeable time and place. At our earliest opportunity, we will also invite you and your partner to a dinner, where a club leader and your sponsor will discuss in greater detail all aspects of Rotary and help you find your service passion.

Are prospective members ever turned down? Prospective members can be turned down because the Membership Committee or the Board of the Club feels that he/she does not meet the qualification for membership or because their Classification has been exceeded (the membership cannot be comprised of more than 10% in any one profession).
